Congratulations to you and your child on selecting an Advanced Placement course! Students who take AP learn the independent study skills and habits of mind that they need to succeed in college and career. Our AP instructors and their curricula are nationally recognized for excellence by the College Board. Please note: part of the experience of enrolling in Bay Path's AP program is taking an AP exam in the spring. **STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED** to take these AP exam(s).

About AP Exams: The Advanced Placement exam is offered by the College Board, and the College Board charges a fee for each AP exam. Note that these fees are assessed **for each AP exam your son/daughter will take.**

PAYMENT DUE DATE: October 18, 2018
 EXAM FEE: \$93. per student, per exam (\$50. per student per exam for those on free/reduced lunch)
 PAYMENT OPTIONS: Pay in person in the Bay Path Business Office **OR** Pay online on the school website.

Testing Support: As part of our AP program, students attend Saturday Study sessions that prepare them for AP exams. These sessions are held at area high schools with many other AP students and teachers from central Massachusetts. *It is expected that your child make every effort to attend these sessions.* Session dates:

What happens if my child drops the AP course? The pre-paid exam fee will only be refunded if the student withdraws from the course prior to November 30, 2018. After that date, *no refunds will be issued*, even if the student withdraws from the AP course and/or does not take the exam.

What if my child enrolls in more than one AP course? Students must pay a fee of \$93. for EACH exam they take.
