

BAY PATH REGIONAL VOCATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL
STUDENT APPLICATION FOR PARKING & DRIVING PRIVILEGE
FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021

From the Student Handbook: *A student who wishes to drive a vehicle to school and park on school property must apply for a permit from the Dean of Students Office. **Attached to the application form (which has been signed by both student and parent/guardian) must be a copy of the student's license, registration, and a letter from the employer on company letterhead (stating time to report to work and hours of employment.)***

IF ANY OF THE ABOVE INFORMATION IS MISSING, THE APPLICATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNTIL COMPLETED.

Permit consideration is given first to seniors for whom having a car is a **necessity**. Students who **must start work before 3:30 p.m.** would be an example of such necessity. **Acquiring a permit is not automatic.** Students must meet the school requirements for attendance, tardy, grades and discipline. The student must be passing all courses. **Students who are failing courses will lose their permit for the quarter, and their grades will be reviewed at the end of the next quarter. Students who do not obey the rules of the road will also be subject to losing their permits.** Parking privileges may be refused on grounds that within the school the student has demonstrated such behavior as to create a doubt as to whether or not the student could possibly pose a danger by the misuse of the vehicle on school grounds. **Parking permits CAN NOT be transferred from one student's car to another student's car, and a student CAN NOT allow another student to use their parking space.**

Consideration of life, property, and the right of others requires the exercise of extreme care by all students who wish to continue to drive their cars to school.

Drivers may be allowed passengers, provided the Dean of Students has verified permission from the parent/guardian of both the driver & the passenger.

There are a minimum number of parking permits available. Qualified student drivers will be given a parking sticker to be displayed in an appropriate place on the vehicle.

The Dean of Students may revoke a student's driving & parking privileges after a hearing if it is determined that a student has misused a vehicle on school grounds. The matter may also be turned over to the Registry of Motor Vehicles for further action. Please refer to the Student Handbook for more information.
