Bay Path Regional Vocational Technical High School offers meals through the National School Breakfast and Lunch Program. Free and Reduced priced meals are offered to those who qualify. Applications can be filled out manually or electronically.

If filing manually - either request an application to be sent to your house or print one from the school website at <http://www.baypath.net> Click the Parent tab and select Free and Reduced Lunch under the Cafeteria section. Fill out all required fields and either send to school with your child or mail to:

If filing electronically – go to the school website: www.baypath.net and click the Parent tab in the upper right hand corner and select the Parent Lunch Portal tab under the Cafeteria Section. Set up your account using your child’s information. Once the account is set up click Submit Application. Fill out all required fields and submit.

Free and Reduced meals are available during the school year. Applications can be submitted at any time throughout the year. All families qualifying through Virtual Gateway will receive a letter of eligibility through the mail. Free meal benefits are extended to all children within a household if one child qualifies through Virtual Gateway.
